



Confined Space Awareness

Course Title:	Confined Space Awareness
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	OSHA 29 CFR 1910.146
Target Groups:	All employees that will be working in or around confined spaces.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	This course will inform employees of the dangers of working in or around confined spaces. It will teach students what confined spaces are and how to identify them in the workplace.
Course Design:	This course is designed for employees who work around confined spaces, but are not part of any confined space related work. It covers the basic hazards of confined spaces as well as the basic precautions and qualifications needed for entry into confined spaces. Emphasis is placed on the proper need for additional training for any personnel who will actually be performing duties in or in support of the confined space entry.
Completion Requirements:	Student must pass written examination with a score of 70% or better.
Course Length:	2 hours.
Class Size:	1 – 20 students.
