

Confined Space Entrant/Attendant

Course Title:	Confined Space Entrant / Attendant
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	OSHA 29 CFR 1910.146 and 29 CFR 1910.134
Target Groups:	All employees that will be assigned to the duty of a confined space entrant or attendant.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	This course will teach the student what confined spaces are, how to recognize them, as well as the necessary training, safety precautions, and duties of the confined space attendant.
Course Design:	The classroom segment will cover confined space safety, atmospheric testing, atmospheric hazards, gas monitors, lockout/tagout, ventilation, hot work, emergency procedures, and rescue.
Completion Requirements:	Classroom presentation followed by a closed book examination, which requires at least a 70% for successful completion.
Course Length:	4 hours.
Class Size:	1 – 20 students.
