Course Structure:	 Course consists of: Classroom segment covering regulations, classification of materials, packaging (manufacture, selection, preparation), hazard communications (shipping documentation, marking, labeling, placarding), material handling and incident reporting. Hands on includes worksheets to ensure understanding and application of DOT Guidebook and Hazardous Material Tables and a practice Bill of Lading to ensure understanding of proper shipping paperwork procedures.
