Course Title:	Electrical Safety - Qualified
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	NFPA 70E OSHA 29 CFR 1910.331-335
Target Groups:	Any employee that will be working on or near exposed energized parts as outlined in NFPA 70E guidelines.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	Students will be provided with the knowledge as well as recommended practices and guidelines to safely perform work around electrical equipment.
Course Design:	This course will cover all necessary aspects of NFPA 70E guidelines, electrical safety definitions, lockout/tagout, electrical labeling, arc flash, PPE, insulated tools used in electrical work, and insulation/shielding materials.
Completion Requirements:	Classroom presentation followed by a written test passed with a score of 70%
Course Length:	8 Hours
Class Size:	1 – 20 students
