Course Title:	Hazard Communication (HAZCOM)

Target Groups:	All levels of employees required to work with or around Hazardous Chemicals or have general knowledge in Hazard Communications.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	This course will provide personnel with knowledge in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- What HAZCOM is and why it's important.- Older HCS standards vs. newer GHS standards.- How to understand the different types of hazard communications.- How to work safely around chemicals in general.
Course Design:	This course covers the different types of Hazard Communications at the work place, how to read and interpret the different types of labels, what are the new GHS standards, and how to stay safe around hazardous chemicals.
Completion Requirements:	Classroom presentation & training videos followed by a closed book examination, which requires at least a 70% for successful completion.
Course Length:	2 – 3 hours.
Class Size:	1 – 20 students.
