

Course Titles:	HAZWOPER Awareness, Incident Commander, Operations, Technician
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	and Specialist 29 CFR 1910.120
Target Groups:	All levels of employees required to exhibit anything from a basic understanding all the way up to an in-depth level of training in HAZWOPER.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	These courses will provide personnel with the annual regulatory training in:  - What is hazardous waste and how it can harm them.  - What to do in case of a hazardous material spill.  - The different types of PPE and ways to protect oneself.  - Roles and responsibilities for each level of HAZWOPER.
Course Design:	The classroom segment in this wide range of courses covers regulations, classification of waste, responsibilities as per one's level of training, how an employee should protect himself in case of a hazardous waste spill, and how to protect the general public from a spill.
Completion Requirements:	Depending on the level of training needed, classroom presentations may last anywhere from 2 hours to 40 hours, followed by a closed book examination, which requires at least a 70% for successful completion. Some levels of training will also require a hands-on practical examination.
Course Length:	Awareness (2 hours), Incident Commander (8 hours), Operations (8 hours), Technician (24 hours), Specialist (40 hours)
Class Size:	2 – 30 students.
