

Course Title:	Hand & Power Tool Safety
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	29 CFR 1926.302 Subpart I 29 CFR 1910.243 NIOSH Publication 2009-113
Target Groups:	All levels of employees required to work with hand or power tools or have involvement and general knowledge in them.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	This course will provide personnel with knowledge in: - When Hand Tools & Power tools are required. - What are the hazards associated with Hand & Power tools. - How to properly utilize Hand & Power tools. - How to perform proper machine guarding with portable tools.
Course Design:	This course covers the importance of proper Hand & Power Tool use in the work place, when protection is necessary, what are the different types of hand & power tools, what the hazards are in regards to hand & power tools, and how to properly machine guard to avoid additional hazards.
Completion Requirements:	Classroom presentation followed by a closed book examination, which requires at least a 70% for successful completion.
Course Length:	1 – 2 hours.
Class Size:	1 – 20 students.
