

Course Title:	Hazard Recognition
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	29 CFR 1910.212 29 CFR 1910.132
Target Groups:	All levels of employees required to search for and control workplace hazards, or anyone who seeks general knowledge in hazard recognition.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	 This course will provide personnel with the following knowledge: What are the different types of hazards. What are the different ways to control these hazards. How to perform a hazard inspection.
Course Design:	This course covers the different types of workplace hazards, how to recognize them, what are the most effective techniques to control them, and how to perform a hazard inspection report.
Completion Requirements:	Classroom presentation followed by a closed book examination, which requires at least a 70% for successful completion.
Course Length:	1 hour.
Class Size:	1 – 20 students.
