



Hearing Conservation

Course Title:	Hearing Conservation
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	OSHA 1910.95
Target Groups:	All employees who are exposed to noise at above an 8-hour time weighted average of 85 decibels in the work place.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	Any employee that is exposed to above 85 decibels should be included in this training program. This will ensure that the student gains an understanding of how noise affects hearing, including hearing loss, and proper PPE selection.
Course Design:	The course will consist of training students in an introduction to noise, explain what noise is and its levels, explain the anatomy of the ear, hearing protection, explain when protection is needed, signs of hearing loss, decibel readings, medical testing, and noise reduction
Completion Requirements:	Student must pass written closed book examination with a score of 70% or better.
Course Length:	2 hours
Class Size:	1 – 20 students
