Course Title:	Lockout / Tagout
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	OSHA 29 CFR 1910.147
Target Groups:	All employees that need to understand the purpose and function of a company required energy control program.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	This training will ensure that the employee understands the purpose and function of the energy control programs. It will also provide students with the knowledge and skills required for the safe application, usage, and removal of energy controls.
Course Design:	The topics covered in this course include the OSHA standard, training requirements, recognition of hazardous energy sources, energy control procedures, locks and tags, six step procedure of LOTO, removal, and special situations.
Completion Requirements:	Classroom presentation followed by a closed book evaluation, which requires at least a 70% for successful completion.
Course Length:	2 Hours
Class Size:	1—20 students
