Course Title:	NORM Awareness
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	OSHA 29 CFR 1910.1096 & BSSE
Target Groups:	All employees who work with or in a potential NORM environment.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	Students shall be instructed in the safety problems associated with exposure to such materials or radiation and precautionary measures to minimize exposure, as well as the report of radiation exposure.
Course Design:	The classroom lecture will cover limits on exposure to radiation and radioactive material, measures to take after exposure, personnel monitoring and equipment, caution signs and labels, exposure records and reports, what is NORM, where is NORM found, and disposal.
Completion Requirements:	Written test passed with a score of 70%
Course Length:	2 Hours
Class Size:	1 – 20 students
