

Course Title:	Respiratory Protection
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	OSHA 29 CFR 1910.134
Target Groups:	All employees who may be exposed to inhalation hazards or any other harmful contaminants, and are subject to wear respiratory protective equipment.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	The students will be trained in the proper use and limitations of respiratory equipment. They will gain an understanding of air contaminants, including IDLH atmospheres, PELs, and the need for selection, proper use, inspection, cleaning, and storage of respirators.
Course Design:	The classroom lecture will include the OSHA standards, responsibilities, procedures and use of respirators, engineering/administrative controls, respirator types/styles, selection, capabilities, limitations, medical exams, maintenance, and fit testing.
Completion Requirements:	Classroom presentation followed by a closed book evaluation, which requires at least a 70% for successful completion.
Course Length:	2 Hours
Class Size:	1—20 students
