

Course Title:	Scaffolding End User
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	OSHA 29 CFR 1926.454
Target Groups:	All employees working on or around scaffolding in General Industry, Construction Industry, and Marine.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	This course will educate employees who use scaffolding on common hazards, issues, and design requirements.
Course Design:	This course covers all of the training as required by OSHA to assure the safety of employees working on or around scaffolding. It will allow the end user to be able to identify issues prior to use and ensure that the scaffold meets the requirements needed in order to be deemed safe for use.
Completion Requirements:	Student must pass written examination with a score of 70% or better.
Course Length:	4 hours
Class Size:	1—25 students
