



Scaffolding Competent Person/ Builder

Course Title:	Scaffolding Competent Person / Builder
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	OSHA 29 CFR 1926.454
Target Groups:	All employees that need to be qualified for scaffold inspection, erection, moving, dismantling, or alteration. Such activities shall be performed only by experienced and trained employees selected for competent person.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	This course addresses the needs of workers who are responsible for building and using scaffolding on the job site. Students will be provided instruction on the safe erection and use of a variety of scaffold types and systems in accordance with OSHA.
Course Design:	The classroom presentation will cover scaffolding user safety, scaffold building tools, PPE, tube and clamp scaffolds, systems scaffolding, and building frame scaffolding. There will also be a hands-on practical that consists of erecting and dismantling of scaffolding.
Completion Requirements:	Classroom presentation followed by a closed book examination, which requires at least a 70% for successful completion. The student will also need to build the required scaffolding system properly.
Course Length:	16 Hours
Class Size:	1—25 students
