



Stop Work Authority

Course Title:	Stop Work Authority
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	OSHA / BSEE – Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement
Target Groups:	All levels of employees who might need to stop work for any unsafe condition in all industries on land and offshore.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	The course is designed to teach students the authority and obligation of any individual to suspend a single work task or group operation when the control of the risk is not clearly established or understood.
Course Design:	This course will take students through the entire process of Stop Work Authority. The topics included are policy, roles and responsibilities, intervention, SWA protocol, reporting, follow-up, and recognition.
Completion Requirements:	Students must pass written closed book examination with a score of 70% or better.
Course Length:	1 Hour
Class Size:	1 – 20 students
