

Course Title:	Vessel Security Awareness
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	33 CFR 104.215 as mandated by the USCG and 13.1 (Part B) & 13.2 (Part A & B) of the ISPS Code
Target Groups:	Company and vessel personnel with security duties.
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	This course is intended to provide the knowledge required for company and vessel personnel with security duties to work in accordance with the Maritime Transportation Security Act of 2002.
Course Design:	The classroom segment includes security threats/patterns, dangerous substance recognition, suspicious behavior, crowd management and control techniques, communications, emergency procedures, contingency plans, security equipment, Vessel Security Plan, MARSEC levels, physical screening methods, and TWIC program.
Completion Requirements:	Classroom presentation followed by passing a written examination.
Course Length:	4 hours.
Class Size:	1 – 20 students.
