



## Water Survival /H.U.E.T.

Course Title:	Water Survival (H.U.E.T.)
Regulatory & Technical Reference:	API RP T-7, T-4, 75 SEMS II and USCG Title 33
Target Groups:	Anyone potentially traveling by Helicopter
Prerequisites:	None.
Objective:	This two-part comprehensive course is intended to train and familiarize personnel with the methods of escape in the case that helicopter was to make an emergency landing on the water, and also teach personnel about what to do in case of an offshore emergency.
Course Design:	This course is designed to train new hires and seasoned employees alike about what are all the different types of offshore emergencies that could be encountered, safe work practices, and escape/survival. HUET (Helicopter Underwater Egress Training) then trains personnel in Helicopter emergencies, how they may occur, and what to do if they do occur.
Completion Requirements:	Students must successfully complete a written exam with at least a 70%. They must also be able to complete the required pool activities including 5 simulations in the HUET (SEFtec simulator).
Course Length:	6 Hours.
Class Size:	1 – 20 students.
